

## “Aichi Toll Road Pass (AIP)” discount plan for foreigners visiting Japan

Aichi Road Concession Co., Ltd. offers the Aichi Toll Road Pass (hereinafter referred to as “AIP”) as a supplemental service of the Central Nippon Expressway Pass (hereinafter referred to as “CEP”), which is service by Central Nippon Expressway Company Limited Nagoya Branch providing foreigners visiting Japan and others with unlimited use of certain expressway at an inexpensive flat rate.

### What is AIP?

This is a service for foreigners visiting Japan providing unlimited use of certain ETC-equipped expressway routes operated by Aichi Road Concession Co., Ltd. at an inexpensive flat rate (for a limited period of time).

### Conditions for use

When applying for CEP, AIP can be selected as an optional add-on, and is not available otherwise.

Please apply via the counter of a designated car rental company before using this service.

### Time period of use

From 2 to 7 or 8 to 14 consecutive days throughout the year, depending on price.

### Eligible vehicles

Vehicles using ETC wireless communication: specifically, an automobile (standard-size vehicle) and an ETC card which are offered by a car rental company.

### Price

•CHUBU Centrair International Airport Expressway: This road serves as a point of departure linking the airport with locations throughout Japan.

•Chita Odan Road: This road connects CHUBU Centrair International Airport

Expressway and Chitahanto Road.

- Chitahanto Road: This road is convenient for traveling to Nagoya city and other locations throughout Japan.
- Minamichita Road: This road is convenient for visiting the southern area of Chita peninsula, which is famous for seafood.
- Nagoya Seto Road: This road is convenient for visiting Seto via the Tomei Expressway. Seto is famous for Expo 2005 Aichi Commemorative Park, the Toyota Automobile Museum, and *setomono*(ceramics).
- Sanage Green Road: This road is convenient for visiting the northern area of Toyota city, which is famous for *washi* (Japanese paper).
